

# Rules

## General Rules

- Jewellery should be kept to a minimum and be discreet.
- All hairstyles and colours must be conventional.
- No make-up.
- No nail polish.
- No chewing gum.
- Skirt style is not to be altered.
- Blouse/shirt must comply with dress code.
- Regulation College backpack must be used.
- Expensive toys i.e. gameboys, personal tape/CD players/ipods are not to be brought to College.
- Mobile phones must be switched off and kept in student bags/lockers during College hours of 8.30 am to 3.30 pm.

## Uniform Rules

The uniform is seen as an integral part of the culture of St Peter's Anglican College. It is distinctive and students wearing it are identified as being members of the College. The uniform is compulsory. The College bag and hat are part of the uniform.

The correct uniform will be worn at all times, both at College and in public.

Summer uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4, with Winter uniform to be worn in Terms 2 and 3. It is recommended that a change-over period of two weeks be granted to students at the beginning of Term 2 and Term 4.

Sports uniform must be worn on Sports day. The College Tracksuit must be worn on Sports Day during Terms 2 and 3. If it is unseasonably hot on Sports day in Terms 2 and 3, summer sports uniform may be worn, but the tracksuit must be worn to and from College on those days.
